Here in Brasil Halloween isn't celebrated, however some schools that have an emphasis on English classes and culture try to incorporate some kind of dress up party for the kiddos during the day. You definitely won't see kiddos dressed up going from house to house asking for candy though. Instead the month of Oct has it's own culturally celebrated holiday which is Children's Day. Children's Day is celebrated in the middle on the month and usual is equipped with a party and present for kiddos. This day is used to honor all the children. In Timoteo, where we are, the city council put on a big free event for all kiddos that lasted a couple hours where children got to play at the park, jump in bouncy houses, eat popcorn, ice cream, and cotton candy and enjoy being a kid.

MissionBrasil took part in providing little goodie bags for the children of the church that are enrolled in English classes. Each baggie had a variety of candies and a personal message with a bible verse in English and Portuguese. Jeremiah 29:11 was the verse chosen and we pray that it sinks into the kiddos and what God has in store for them.

Thanksgiving is another holiday not celebrated in Brasil, but the English class did go over some holiday vocabulary and they were in shock to find out that Americans don't eat beans and rice everyday. It's a big world out there full of diversity and tons to learn.
